






Dimensions (Front and Side View)




When the device is operational and linked to a network, you can use the Reset Test Function Management (RTFM) button (SW1 [see picture]) to restore the device to the factory default settings.

To restore the device to factory default


- Press and hold the RTFM button for longer than five seconds.
